

## Meeting the Needs of Gifted Students in the General Education Classroom

### *Did you Know...*

New Gifted Operating Standards mandate general education teachers providing gifted services receive a total of 60 hours of high quality gifted professional development within a two-year period (the first 30 hours must be completed in Year I).

The North Central Ohio Educational Service Center will be providing the following online, self-paced professional opportunities to fulfill the 30 hour requirement in Year I. These modules address the operating standard competencies outlined within the Ohio Revised Code.

**Date/Time:** Self-paced, Online Modules

**Audience:** General Education teachers who need to meet Year I requirements of serving gifted students

**Cost per Teacher for Online Modules:** \$85 per module (6 hours) or \$375 for all modules (30 hours)  
or **FREE** for districts receiving 0.2 gifted services from NCOESC during the 2017-2018 school year

**Graduate Credit:** Two graduate credits are available through Ashland University for an additional cost of \$556.00
